The Rantings of a Mac Man

When our two younger children were teenagers, we were putting away groceries after a trip to the supermarket. My son, being a bit of a jokester, (I wonder where he got that trait?) threatened to hit his little sister. He grabbed a can of Pam cooking spray and threatened that he was going to hit her in the head. He swung the can down toward her forehead a couple of times stopping before it hit her. However, when he grabbed the can he grabbed it by the lid. On his second swing when he stopped, the can popped off the lid and continued on toward her forehead. The can smacked her head and cut her. We know that it was not his intention to hurt her but she still carries the scar on her forehead.

Sometimes we hurt each other and, perhaps, we may not even want to but it happens. Not long before we moved, our associate minister at the Missouri Street church came and asked me if I knew so-and-so. I did not know the man. He was not a member but an occasional attendee who came infrequently. This man told the minister that I had a judgmental attitude toward him. He asked the man how he knew that. The man said that one time I was walking up the church aisle and scowled at him in a judgmental way. I can say it was hard for me to be judgmental when I knew nothing about him and I was probably scowling because it was difficult for me to walk. But it does demonstrate how just being around each other can cause a hurt. Paul wrote:

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Eph. 4:31-32

Why would he write that if there wasn't a chance at us hurting one another? And so we will try not to be hurtful and we will follow Paul's teaching to be kind, compassionate and forgiving.
